EYFS Statutory Baseline Assessment-

If your child is in Reception they will participate in the reception baseline assessment (RBA) within the first 6 weeks of starting reception. The purpose of the assessment is to provide the starting point for a progress measure that will help parents understand how well schools support their children to progress between reception and year 6.

This is a short, interactive and practical assessment of your child's early literacy, communication, language and mathematics skills when they begin school. The main purpose is to create a starting point to measure the progress schools make with their pupils. It is not about judging or labelling your child or putting them under any pressure. Your child cannot 'pass' or 'fail' the assessment.

Please do not feel that this is a judgement or something your child should worry about.

Magnet Safety-

The Child Accident Prevention Trust (CAPT) warns that more than 300 children a year are rushed to A&E after swallowing magnets and one in ten needs life-saving surgery.

When strong magnets stick together inside the body, they can rip through a child's gut, cutting off blood supply and causing life-threatening injuries. Even toddlers have needed hours of emergency surgery, and some children are left with lasting internal damage.

Magnets don't just come in toys – they're also found in jewellery kits, fridge magnets, puzzles, dartboards, fidget toys and desk gadgets. Worryingly, some magnets sold online are 17 times stronger than the UK

The advice for parents is:

- Buy only from trusted brands and retailers.
- Be cautious with cheap copies and online marketplaces.
- Keep magnets and products containing them out of children's reach.

11+ Support-

Maidstone Grammar School has partnered with Atom Learning to provide free learning and 11+ preparation support to all primary school children (both boys and girls) who are eligible for Pupil Premium.

Eligible students will receive access to Atom Home for free (normally £575.90 a year). This support is open to all KS2 students, not just those considering selective schools for secondary.

Atom Learning provides Key Stage 2 learning and 11+ preparation for ages 7-11. This is an online learning platform helping to build children's confidence with KS2 learning objectives and, where relevant, familiarises them with 11+ exam questions and practice tests. Through their account, children can access questions, resources, video tutorials and mock tests. Parents/carers need to complete the form on this page:
