## Kent test (11 +)-

Should you wish to register your child for the Kent Test (the 11+), which will take place in September you will need to sign up for this.

Registration opens **2nd June**- parents/carers can apply online at <a href="https://www.kent.gov.uk/education-and-children/schools/school-places/kent-test">https://www.kent.gov.uk/education-and-children/schools/school-places/kent-test</a>. **Registration closes 1 July 2025** 

You will need to register your child online to sit the test in September if you wish to apply for them to attend a Grammar School.

The Kent test will take place in school on **Thursday 11th September 2025.** If you register your child for the test, they must be in school on this date to take the test.

Please speak to your child's class teacher if you have any questions about your child's suitability for the test.
