Next academic year Aspire will again be going to Bowles Rocks in Tunbridge Wells for a three day (two nights) residential educational adventure activity course. Children in Years 5 and 6 from across the Aspire Federation of schools are invited to attend.

The residential will run from **Wednesday 3rd December to Friday 5**<sup>th</sup> **December 2025.** There will also be some different activities, such as orienteering, archery and skiing.

Cost per child for accommodation, full board catering and instructed activities is £213 (£110 if your child receives free school meals).
