## **Online Safety-**

How Safe is WhatsApp for Children - NSPCC

WhatsApp is one of the most popular instant messaging apps, used by over 2 billion people in 180 countries. This allows people to connect with people individually or join group chats where lots of people can contribute.

Although rated at 16+, all that is required is a phone number, however, children and young people can easily subvert the restrictions placed on its access. All it takes is one child in a class to be on whatsapp, and all the others will wish to join. This can lead to increased vulnerabilities for child users.
