

## Message from Mrs Parsons

Welcome back to Term 4! We've enjoyed a positive start to the new term. Children began with a special Nurture Day focused on behaviour, kindness, and living out our Christian values in all that we do – a lovely way to set the tone for the weeks ahead.

Attendance has been fantastic this week, and we would like to say a huge thank you to everyone for making such a strong effort to ensure children are in school every day. As I often say in Celebration Worship, it truly makes me very happy to see so many children at school!



This week in worship, we began discussing the season of Lent, remembering the time Jesus spent 40 days in the wilderness, fasting and praying as he prepared for his ministry and the journey toward Easter. Together we explored Luke 4:1–12 and wondered how Jesus found the strength and wisdom he needed, what his response to temptation shows us about the kind of teacher and leader he would be, and what we can learn for our own moments of struggle. We closed with a simple prayer, asking God to help us be strong when we are tempted and to guide us toward what is right.
