This week of worship has been focused on 'Glimpses of the Kingdom' we have looked at the story the parable of the net/fish.

Matthew 13:47-48 King James Version

Again, the kingdom of heaven is like unto a net, that was cast into the sea, and gathered of every kind: which, when it was full, they drew to shore, and sat down, and gathered the good into vessels, but cast the bad away.

We have discussed the meaning of this parable. People often accused Jesus of teaching them hard things: the message in this parable was a hard one about making Kingdom choices – and about the consequences of making bad choices.
