This week we have continued discussing how the advent story is put together by looking at different elements each day.

Isaiah 11:1-11

A shoot will come up from the stump of Jesse; from his roots a Branch will bear fruit.

The Spirit of the Lord will rest on him— the Spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the Spirit of counsel and of might, the Spirit of the knowledge and fear of the Lord — and he will delight in the fear of the Lord.

We have asked ourselves these questions:

I wonder what a prophet is? I wonder what a prophecy is? I wonder why this passage is read at Christmas services?

Isaiah was an important prophet in the Big Story of the Bible. He looked forward to how the world might look in the future – he looked forward to the Kingdom of God and he used pictures to talk about what that Kingdom might look like and talked about the one who would bring that Kingdom.
