This week in worship we have been focusing on the Easter story and significant days and events.

Mark 11:1-11

Jesus Comes to Jerusalem as King

11 As they approached Jerusalem and came to Bethphage and Bethany at the Mount of Olives, Jesus sent two of his disciples, 2 saying to them, "Go to the village ahead of you, and just as you enter it, you will find a colt tied there, which no one has ever ridden. Untie it and bring it here. 3 If anyone asks you, 'Why are you doing this?' say, 'The Lord needs it and will send it back here shortly.'"

4 They went and found a colt outside in the street, tied at a doorway. As they untied it, 5 some people standing there asked, "What are you doing, untying that colt?" 6 They answered as Jesus had told them to, and the people let them go. 7 When they brought the colt to Jesus and threw their cloaks over it, he sat on it. 8 Many people spread their cloaks on the road, while others spread branches they had cut in the fields. 9 Those who went ahead and those who followed shouted, "Hosanna!

We have discussed this passage and what this tells us about who Jesus is and what Jesus is like? We asked the question why did people find palm branches and shout 'Hosanna'? We then discussed what makes us clap and cheer?

PE and Earrings Reminder

Jewellery is not allowed to be worn in school, for safety reasons.

One pair of small stud earrings is permitted for pierced ears only if absolutely necessary (see example below). Any parents who feel they/their child cannot comply with this request must inform school staff why. If your child does wear stud earrings to school, on days when physical/sport activities take place they must:

- Be able to remove their earrings before the activity (either in school or at home).
- Be responsible for any jewellery removed.
- Cover earrings with Micropore tape (bought in from home), if they can't remove them by themselves.
