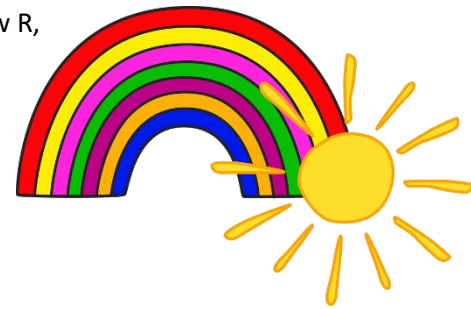
## Maths Rainbow Challenge
