If we offer and accept forgiveness, it can be like watching something dissolvedissolve our eyes. We have been reminded that actions often have consequences and that the consequences may go on even after the person has been forgiven. Forgiveness itself may need to be an ongoing, conscious process. However, forgiving and being forgiven is often an important part of feeling at peace in body, mind and spirit.



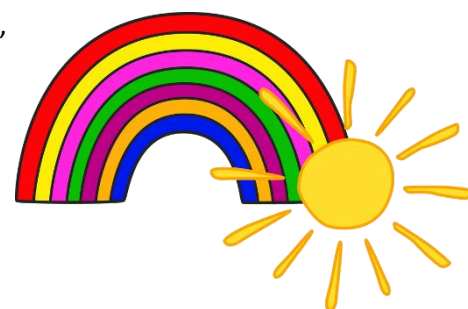
