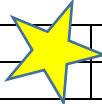

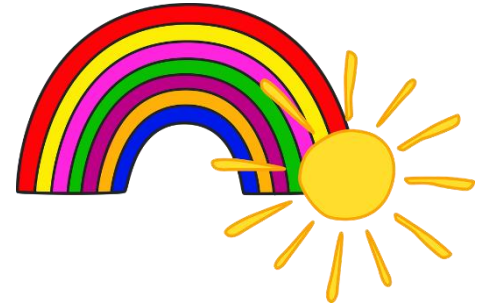
Reading Bugs
