Even though there was no reason to find Jesus guilty, the chief priests and elders of the people decided that he must be put to death. They took Jesus to Pilate, the Roman Governor for the region, to be condemned, but Pilate could not find him guilty of any crime. The chief priests and elders insisted, "We have a law" they told Pilate, "Jesus must die because he has claimed to be the Son of God." Pilate was

worried about this. He took a bowl of water and washed his hands to show that he would take no further responsibility for what happened to Jesus and he handed him over to be crucified.

I wonder what you think about when you think about how Jesus' hands were bound. He is a prisoner even though he has done nothing wrong. I wonder how it might feel to be unjustly accused and treated as a criminal.

God our Father, Thank you that on the very first Good Friday, you stretched out your arms on the cross and embraced the whole world in love. AMEN
