This week in worship we focused on transition, whether that was going into a new year at primary school or moving on to pastures new. We thought about muddy boots and the story of Luke 22:54-62 and John 21:15-17.

We talked about how the mud from dirty boots gets everywhere – especially on clean floors! Like our walking boots easily get dirty, and need a clean, the same is also true of our hearts. It's very easy for each one of us to do or say things that hurt others and it's often much harder than we imagined to put these things right.

Linked to the bible stories, Luke 22:54-62 describes Peter's denial of Jesus out of fear during Jesus' trial, while John 21:15-17 portrays Jesus restoring Peter after the resurrection by asking him three times if he loves him and commissioning him to "feed my sheep." These passages highlight the importance of love and service in following Jesus.

We can all be sure that at one time or another, we will do things that hurt others or make them sad – and in school, we try to say sorry and to forgive each other. Remember that as you travel through life in the future.
