

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# All different, all equally valued Matthew 6:28-29

"And why do you worry about clothes? See how the flowers of the field grow. They do not labour or spin. Yet I tell you that not even Solomon in all his splendor was dressed like one of these."

This week in worship, we thought about how we are all different, but equally loved by God. We looked at pictures of wild flowers and thought about how Jesus spoke about the flowers he saw in the field around him and how we can learn something from them. When we see the wild flowers, we see and marvel at the host of beautiful colours. We do not think to say, 'Oh, I see no yellow, I see no blue or pink, they are all the same!' We are jubilant because they are all so beautifully different, reminding us of our own uniqueness and ability to bring a smile to the face of those who love us.


