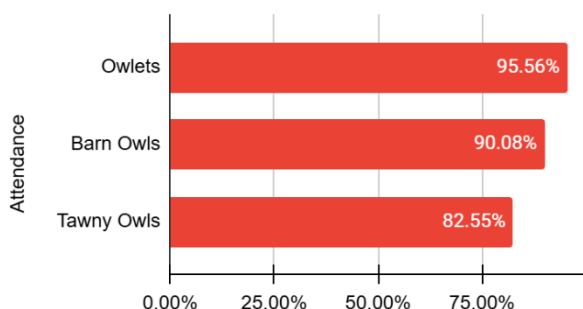

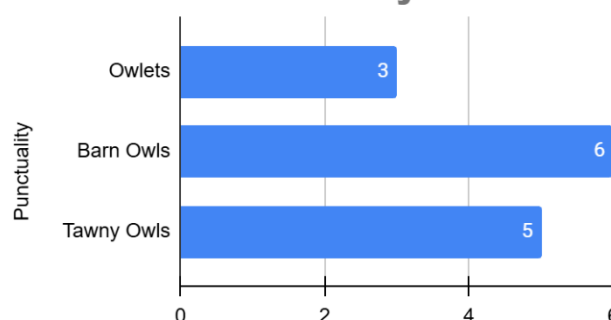
Attendance and Punctuality
