

This week in worship, the children began the season of Advent, focusing on the theme of Hope as we lit the first candle on the Advent wreath.

We explored the idea of *waiting*—what we wait for and how waiting can sometimes feel busy or unsettled. Using examples like a jar of muddy water, we thought about how our lives can feel rushed, and how Advent invites us to slow down.

The children learned that Advent is a time of waiting for Jesus, the Light of the World, and we talked about the meaning of the five candles on the Advent wreath: four for the Sundays leading up to Christmas, and the final one lit on Christmas Day.

We spent time reflecting on how the simple act of lighting a candle can bring calm and peace, and what "hope" looks like as we wait for Christmas. The children were encouraged to take a quiet moment to focus on hope.




