Can you draw a picture of their flag?</p> 	<p><u>Counting Practise</u> Receptions are counting to 10, Year 1s are learning to count backwards from 20. Ask your grown up to record you counting.</p> 
<p><u>Special Celebration</u> Draw a picture of a time when you celebrated something special. It could be a birthday, Christmas, or something else.</p> 	<p><u>Taller and Shorter</u> Hunt at home for things or people that are taller or shorter than you.
