Create a Shield or Banner Design and decorate your own Anglo-Saxon or Viking shield! • Use paper, cardboard, or a cereal box. • Include a symbol that represents <i>you</i> (e.g., bravery, family, friendship). • Write a short explanation: <i>What does your design mean?</i>	Viking Raid Newspaper Report Pretend you are a villager writing for the “Wessex Weekly” the day after a Viking raid! • Use dramatic headlines (“Vikings Invade Village!”). • Include quotes from “witnesses”. • Add a sketch of what you saw.	Time Traveller’s Diary Imagine you went back in time to live in an Anglo-Saxon village. • What did you eat, wear, and do for fun? • Describe one exciting or scary event.
Planet Top Trumps Create your own “Top Trumps” cards for the planets! • Include facts: size, number of moons, temperature, distance from the Sun. • Decorate each with colour and creativity.	Space Poetry Challenge Write a short poem about space — it could be an <i>acrostic</i>, <i>haiku</i>, or <i>rhyming couplet</i>. • Try to include space vocabulary (orbit, galaxy, rocket, crater).	Make a Moon Phase Model • Use Oreos, paper plates, or drawings to show the phases of the Moon. • Label each one: new moon, full moon, crescent, etc.
French Weather Forecast Become a French weather reporter! • Write or record a short weather forecast in French (e.g., <i>Il fait froid à Paris!</i>) • You could draw a weather map and use speech bubbles.	Design a Toy for Santa’s Workshop • Draw or make a model of a new Christmas toy. • Label it with its name, materials, and what makes it special. • Write a few sentences persuading Santa why your toy should be made!	Baroque Music Mood Board • Listen to a short piece of Baroque music (e.g., Bach, Handel, Vivaldi). • Create a “mood board” — drawings, colours, or words that show how it makes you feel. • Optional: find out one fact about the composer.
