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## Tawny Owls – Visit to Sevenoaks Wildlife Reserve – 27.01.26

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are pleased to inform you that children in Years 4, 5 and 6 will be taking part in an educational visit to **Sevenoaks Wildlife Reserve (Kent Wildlife Trust)**.

This visit will support the children's learning through hands-on, outdoor workshops entitled "**Rivers and Beavers**", allowing pupils to explore river habitats and learn about wildlife in a real-life environment. This will link to our Geography curriculum this term.

### Trip details are as follows:

The trip will take place on Tuesday 27th January. The children will leave Ulcombe School at 9:00am and will return by the end of the school day. They will be driven by the school minibus.

### Clothing and equipment:

As part of the workshop, children will be working in and around a river. Therefore, children will need to wear:

- Long-sleeved clothing
- Waterproof coat
- Waterproof trousers
- **Wellington boots (all children must wear these)**

Please ensure clothing is suitable for outdoor learning and may get wet or muddy. The children will be outside for a large portion of the day, so please provide lots of layers and warm clothing such as hats, scarves and gloves.

### Lunch arrangements:

Children will need to bring a **packed lunch** on the day of the trip. If your child receives free school meals and requires a packed lunch, please indicate this clearly on the permission slip.

To help cover the cost of the trip, we kindly request a **voluntary contribution of £8.50 per child**.

Please note that this contribution is voluntary and if you need any assistance covering the cost, please speak with the school office. Please complete and return the permission slip, along with payment, by **Friday 23rd January**.

There are a limited number of parent places available on this trip; if you would be willing to help, please speak to Miss Tapsell or Mrs Rumsey to find out more details.
