<p>History: Maya Mystery Message Create a secret message using symbols or picture-style writing and include a decoding key. How to record: Draw/write the message and key on paper. Add one sentence explaining your symbols.</p>	<p>History: Time-Travel Diary Write a diary entry imagining a day in the life of a Maya child. How to record: Half to one page of writing. Add a small illustration if you wish.</p>	<p>Science: Floating Test Predict and test which small household objects float or sink. How to record: Simple table: <i>Object / Prediction / Result</i>.</p>
<p>Science: Paper Plane Experiment Make different paper planes and test which flies farthest. How to record: List designs and distances flown. Brief conclusion sentence.</p>	<p>Easter Symbols Draw or find common Easter symbols and explain their meanings. How to record: Drawings with short labels or captions.</p>	<p>Storyboard the Easter Story Retell the Easter story as a comic strip or storyboard. How to record: Sequence of pictures with short descriptions.</p>
<p>French Café Menu Design a café menu using French names of fruit and vegetables. How to record: Illustrated menu with clear vocabulary.</p>	<p>DT: Bridge Designer Design a “bridge of the future” with labelled features. How to record: Detailed drawing with labels and brief explanation.</p>	<p>DT: Paper Bridge Challenge Build a paper bridge that holds as many coins as possible. How to record: Photo or drawing + number of coins held.</p>
